■ FOUR DAYS AFTER SEPT. 11, celebrated New York songwriter **Marc Farre** wrote "Prayer Song," a piece inspired by the missing-person posters that were hanging all over the city in the days and weeks after.

"It came to me very fast," Farre says of the song, which you can hear at marcfarr.com. "There was a tangible sense of tragedy everywhere. I was trying to send them love and light."

"New York was so wide open emotionally," says Farre. "For a brief, shining moment, there was a sense that new things were possible. But eventually it all died off."

"We're back to the selfishness — and the greed. I still think the city changed, but I wish it had changed more."
